- Bioceanic Corridor or Bioceanic Route (https://corredorbioceanico.org/en/)
$\rightarrow$ Engineering project under development in South America among Brazil, Paraguai, Argentina, and Chile
$\rightarrow$ Purpose: create an efficient highway that connects by land the Atlantic Ocean (from the port of Santos, in Brazil) and the Pacific Ocean (to the ports of Chile).
